

Update on Park Station

Dear La Mesa Community Member,

Thank you for your continued interest in Park Station!

We are happy to report that Park Station is currently moving forward through the City's environmental review process. Our next milestone is the release of the draft Environmental Impact Report, or DEIR, which is scheduled for public release this summer. As this milestone draws closer, we will let you know how you can participate.

Our team continues to meet with members of the community, local business owners, civic organizations and others who are interested in finding out more about Park Station. To date, we have spoken with more than 1,000 people in La Mesa and met with more than 20 community groups. In addition, we have received a few questions about Park Station and our relationship with the American Legion La Mesa Post 282. My family has been friends and neighbors with the Legion for more than 50 years. In 2008, the Legion agreed to be a co-applicant with us when we originally submitted Park Station to the City of La Mesa. Nothing has changed since this time. The Legion continues to be a co-applicant with us. If the city approves our proposal, this arrangement provides the Legion with the flexibility to incorporate their Post into the Park Station project, potentially relocate or stay exactly where they are.
